

LABOR DAY 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel for the Labor Day weekend at noon on Friday, Sept. 2 until noon on Tuesday, Sept. 6. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Fredericksburg District in the following locations:

Stafford County/Spotsylvania County/City of Fredericksburg

I-95 – Improve 95 construction projects between exits 148 (Quantico) and 126 (Spotsylvania). Shoulder closures northbound and southbound.

Caroline County/Spotsylvania County/City of Fredericksburg

I-95 northbound - Variable speed limits are in place between exits 110 (Ladysmith) and 130 (Route 3), at mile markers 115-130. Speed limits will vary between 35 mph and 70 mph in response to real-time traffic conditions.

King George County

Route 301 - Replacement of the Nice/Middleton Bridge over the Potomac River. Lane closures in place between the weigh station and the bridge.

Mathews County

Route 223 (Old Ferry Road) - Bridge maintenance project over Milford Haven. One-way, alternating traffic controlled by temporary traffic signals at the bridge connecting Gwynn's Island with mainland Mathews County. Bridge openings for marine traffic have also been suspended.

Richmond County

Route 360 - Intersection improvement project. A single eastbound lane and westbound lane are closed near Route 619 (Rich Neck Road/Mulberry Road).
