

THANKSGIVING 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for travel for the Thanksgiving holiday at noon on Wednesday, Nov. 23 until noon on Monday, Nov. 28. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Bristol District in the following locations:

Dickenson County

Route 80 (Sandlick Road) – Bridge rehabilitation project near the intersection of Route 605 (Russell Fork River Road) Temporary traffic signals will control one-way traffic across the bridge.

Scott County

Route 23 – Bridge rehabilitation over Speers Ferry. The northbound bridge is closed. Traffic is restricted to one 11-foot-wide lane in each direction across the southbound bridge.

Washington County

I-81 – Traffic flow project at exit 17 in Abingdon. Narrowed shoulders northbound near the exit.

Route 58 – Road widening and bridge construction in the Damascus area from east of Route 708 (Bethel Road) to east of Route 858 (Hollyfield Road). Traffic along the South Fork Holston River and the Virginia Creeper Trail will be periodically impacted.

Wise County

Business Route 23 – Road widening between Route 23 at McDonald's and Cherry Street. Allow extra travel time.

Wythe County

I-77 – Bridge replacement between mile markers 44 and 42 (Cove Creek Bridges). Altered traffic pattern on I-77 north and southbound in place.
