

## THANKSGIVING 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for travel for the Thanksgiving holiday at noon on Wednesday, Nov. 23 until noon on Monday, Nov. 28. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Culpeper District in the following locations:

### **Albemarle County**

**U.S. 250 (Richmond Road) at Interstate 64** - Construction of a diverging diamond interchange. Intermittent lane traffic controlled by flaggers, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Speed limit reduced to 25 mph.

**U.S. 250 (Rockfish Gap Turnpike) at Route 151 (Critzler Shop Road)** - Construction of a roundabout. Shoulders closed between 6:30 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. Speed limit reduced to 25 mph.

### **Fauquier County**

**U.S. 17 (Marsh Road)** – Replacing southbound bridge over the railroad and Route 805 (Bealeton Road). Right lane and right shoulder closures from Route 656 (Remington Road) to Route 661 (Schoolhouse Road).

### **Greene County**

**U.S. 33 (Spotswood Trail)** – Road reconstruction. Both shoulders are closed between Route 680 (Pinewood Court) and U.S. 29 (Seminole Trail) in the eastbound and westbound lanes. Traffic is diverted onto the newly constructed eastbound lanes while crews reconstruct the westbound lanes. There will be no work the week of Thanksgiving.
