

## THANKSGIVING 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for travel for the Thanksgiving holiday at noon on Wednesday, Nov. 23 until noon on Monday, Nov. 28. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Fredericksburg District in the following locations:

### Caroline County/Spotsylvania County/City of Fredericksburg

**I-95 Northbound** – Variable speed limits between exits 110 (Ladysmith) and 130 (Route 3). Be prepared to adjust speeds based on conditions ahead.

### Mathews County

**Route 223 (Old Ferry Road) over Milford Haven** – Bridge maintenance project. Temporary signals will control one-way, alternating traffic at the bridge connecting Gwynn's Island with mainland Mathews County.

### Richmond County

**Route 360** – Intersection improvement project. A single eastbound lane and westbound lane are closed near Route 619 (Rich Neck Road/Mulberry Road).

### Stafford County/Spotsylvania County/City of Fredericksburg

**I-95** – Improve 95 construction projects between exits 148 (Quantico) and 126 (Spotsylvania). Shoulder closures northbound and southbound. Height restriction of 15 feet, 2 inches in place at mile marker 138.

**I-95** – New traffic pattern for northbound Interstate 95 traffic exiting to Route 17 northbound to Warrenton and southbound to Falmouth. All traffic exiting northbound I-95 will use a new, single off-ramp. Travelers entering I-95 from Route 17 will use a single on-ramp.
