

THANKSGIVING 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for travel for the Thanksgiving holiday at noon on Wednesday, Nov. 23 until noon on Monday, Nov. 28. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Hampton Roads District in the following locations:

City of Norfolk/City of Hampton

HRBT Expansion Project (I-64 east and west from Settlers Landing Road in Hampton to I-564 in Norfolk) – Roadway widening. All travel lanes open. Concrete barriers in place along the shoulder throughout the work zone.

- West Evans Street from Executive Drive to Granby Street closed in both directions to allow crews to work to widen the I-64 overpass. A detour will be in place.
- Mason Creek Road under the I-64 overpass closed in both directions to vehicular traffic to allow crews to widen the overpass. A detour will be in place.

City of Chesapeake

I-64 – Interstate widening project. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions between I-264/Bowers Hill and I-64 Battlefield Boulevard.

City of Newport News

Route 173 (Denbigh Boulevard) over I-64 – Bridge replacement between Jefferson Avenue and Warwick Boulevard. Bridge traffic reduced to one lane in each direction. Access to and from Denbigh Boulevard at Richneck Road closed. Shoulders closed with concrete barriers in place.

City of Virginia Beach

Laskin Road – Road reconstruction and bridge replacement from Republic Road to Red Robin Road. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in both directions throughout the work zone.

Southampton County

Route 189 – Bridge replacement. Route 189 (South Quay Road) is closed in both directions between Route 58 and Route 714 with a signed detour in place.

Isle of Wight County

Route 460 – Bridge replacement. Route 460 east and west is limited to one lane in each direction. The temporary road configuration will include the use of barriers and markers to delineate lanes. Wide loads exceeding 10 feet 6 inches are advised to use alternate routes.

Additional Information

I-64/I-264/I-564 HOV Diamond Lanes and 64 Express Lanes – HOV Restrictions and Express Lanes tolls will be lifted on Thursday, Nov. 24. The 64 Express Lanes in Norfolk are free and open to all motorists outside of normal operating hours.
