

THANKSGIVING 2022

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel for the Thanksgiving holiday at noon on Wednesday, Nov. 23 until noon on Monday, Nov. 28. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Lynchburg District in the following locations:

City of Lynchburg

Route 29/Route 460 – Bridge replacement over Norfolk Southern Railroad. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph in the work zone for northbound and southbound directions.

Campbell County

Route 460 Business/Route 622 – Safety improvements to Waterlick and Timberlake Road Intersection. Traffic reduced to one lane along Route 622 in some locations.

Halifax County

Route 501/Route 610 – Safety improvements project, with added passing lanes to Route 501. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in the work zone at all times.

Nelson County

Route 60 – Bridge rehabilitation over the James River. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph in the work zone. Traffic restricted to one lane with a width restriction of 11-feet. Temporary signals and signage in place.

Pittsylvania County

Route 29 – Bridge rehabilitation over Banister River. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph in the work zone. Traffic restricted to one lane in northbound and southbound directions.
