Find out about a project to improve traffic flow and safety at and around the intersection of Route 460 and Route 697 (Camp Jaycee Road) in Bedford County. The project includes eliminating left turn movements onto and off of Camp Jaycee Road, constructing median turn lanes for U-turns and closing four existing crossovers. The crossover at the nearby nursing home will remain open for emergency vehicles traveling eastbound on Route 460.

The hearing will be held in an “open-house” format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.

Review the project information and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or after the public hearing at VDOT’s Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave, Salem VA, 540-387-5353, 800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711.
