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SUPERSTRUCTURE REPLACEMENT IN ALBEMARLE CO. SHUTS DOWN RT. 810

VDOT Crews will close the bridge over Rock Bar Branch until July 29

CULPEPER — On Monday, May 23, the Virginia Department of Transportation will begin a project in Crozet to replace the bridge over Rock Bar Branch. State force bridge crews will replace the superstructure and repair parts of the substructure.

Route 810 (Blackwells Hollow Road) in Albemarle County, will shut down, starting at 7 a.m., Monday, May 23 and remain closed for the duration of the project, which has a completion date of July 29, 2022.

Route 810 will be closed 0.68 miles from Route 687 (Shiffletts Mill Road) and 0.53 miles from Route 601 (Garth Road), but a temporary pedestrian bridge will be in place for walkers, runners and bicyclists.

Drivers should stay alert for bridge crews working in the area and message boards are in place to direct traffic around the construction.
