**ROUTE 619 REOPENS TO TRAFFIC WHILE BRIDGE RAIL REPAIR
PROJECT NEARS COMPLETION**

Roadway reopen to traffic as of Nov. 10

GREENSVILLE COUNTY – As of Nov. 10, Route 619 (Purdy Road) in Greensville County has reopened to traffic. Lane closures will continue to take place as needed over the next few weeks to finish final construction items related to the bridge rail repair project; however, traffic will be maintained in both directions under flagger control.

A closure of Route 619 (Purdy Road) between Route 651 (Nottoway Road) and Route 656 (Hunt Road) and detour had previously been in place since Oct. 25 to allow for bridge rail repair.
