## **JAMESTOWN-SCOTLAND FERRY OPERATING AT REDUCED CAPACITY**

*Motorists encouraged to view traffic queues before seeking alternate route*

**SURRY COUNTY** – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) advises Jamestown-Scotland Ferry motorists to expect travel delays due to emergent maintenance repairs that will result in single vessel operations until complete. The Surry ferry is in operation and continues to ferry motorists across the James River.

Motorists should expect temporary delays and are encouraged to view the traffic queues approximately one-half mile from the boarding locations in real-time on the [VDOT 511 cameras](#) to determine if an alternate route is needed.

The ferry is free and operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
