

THANKSGIVING 2021

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel from noon Wednesday, Nov. 24, until noon Monday, Nov. 29. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Hampton Roads District in the following locations:

City of Norfolk/City of Hampton

HRBT Expansion Project (I-64 east and west from Settlers Landing Road to I-564) – Roadway widening. All travel lanes open. Concrete barriers in place along the shoulder throughout the work zone.

- W. Evans Street from Executive Drive to Granby Street closed in both directions to allow crews to work to widen the I-64 overpass. A detour will be in place.
- Mallory Street Bridge over I-64 – The lane capacity has been reduced to one lane in each direction. The lane reduction will allow crews to work to widen the bridge.

City of Chesapeake

I-64 – Widening interstate between I-264/Bowers Hill and Battlefield Boulevard. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions through the work zone.

James City County

Route 612 (Longhill Road) – Widening Longhill Road from east of Williamsburg West Drive to Glenburnie Road. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in both directions through the work zone.

City of Newport News

Route 173 (Denbigh Boulevard) over I-64 Bridge – Bridge replacement. Bridge traffic on Denbigh Boulevard reduced to one lane in each direction. Access to Denbigh Boulevard from Richneck Road closed. Shoulders closed with concrete barriers in place on I-64 in both directions at the Denbigh Boulevard overpass. Long-term lane shift in place on I-64 west at the Denbigh Boulevard overpass with concrete barriers in place.

Southampton County

Route 189 – Bridge replacement. Route 189 is closed in both directions between Route 58 and Route 714 with a signed detour in place.

City of Virginia Beach

Laskin Road – Road reconstruction and bridge replacement. Portion of Fremac Drive closed to traffic. Signed detour in place.

York County

I-64 – Widening interstate from Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) to Route 199/Lightfoot (exit 234). Speed limit reduced to 55 mph westbound through the work zone.

Additional Information
